RULING

**DISPOSITON: MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED;
EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION GRANTED**

On October 24, 2022, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission filed a motion to modify the procedural schedule in this docket to extend the due date for Staff’s Public Meeting Memorandum. Staff requests to extend the deadline to file the memorandum from October 25, 2022, to October 28, 2022. Staff states that this extension is to allow it additional time to finalize and file the memorandum. Additionally, Staff proposes to extend the deadline for final comments on its Public Meeting Memorandum from November 15, 2022, to November 18, 2022.
