DISPOSITION: APPLICATIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION DENIED

We deny the applications for reconsideration of Order No. 19-255 filed by Alfalfa Solar I LLC, Dayton Solar I LLC, Fort Rock Solar I LLC, Fort Rock Solar II LLC, Harney Solar I LLC, Riley Solar I LLC, Starvation Solar I LLC, Tygh Valley Solar I LLC, and Wasco Solar I, LLC (defendants or NewSun QFs) and Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC), the Community Renewable Energy Association (CREA) and the Renewable Energy Coalition (the Coalition, and together with NIPPC and CREA, the Intervenors).

In Order No. 19-255, entered August 2, 2019, we granted the motion of Portland General Electric Company (PGE) for summary judgment, finding that the contract language provided that the commencement date for the period of fixed prices was the date on which each contract had been executed by both parties, and denied the motions for summary judgment filed by the NewSun QFs by and the Intervenors. On October 1, 2019, NewSun QFs and the Intervenors filed separate Applications for Reconsideration.

PGE filed a response on October 16, 2019; defendants filed a reply on October 23, 2019; and PGE filed a sur-reply on November 4, 2019.

We have carefully reviewed our prior order, the separate Applications for Reconsideration, the PGE response and the replies, and decline to reconsider Order No. 19-255.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Applications for Reconsideration of Order No. 19-255 filed by Alfalfa Solar I LLC, Dayton Solar I LLC, Fort Rock Solar I LLC, Fort Rock Solar II LLC, Fort Rock Solar II LLC, Fort Rock Solar IV LLC, Harney Solar I LLC, Riley Solar I LLC, Starvation Solar I LLC, Tygh Valley Solar I LLC, and Wasco Solar I, LLC and by Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, the Community Renewable Energy Association, and the Renewable Energy Coalition are denied.
