RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On January 20, 2021, Portland General Electric Company filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file its Reply to the Responses to PGE's Motion to Lift Suspension filed by the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, NewSun Energy, LLC, Obsidian Renewables, LLC, Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, Renewable Energy Coalition, and Community Renewable Energy Association (collectively, the parties). Although the responses were filed on varying dates, PGE requests that it be permitted to respond by filing a consolidated reply to all parties no later than January 26, 2021, and asks that its motion be given expedited consideration. In support of its motion, PGE represents that it has conferred with all parties and that none oppose its motion requesting an extension of time in which to file its reply.

RULING

Given the imminent deadline for PGE to file its reply and the representation that all parties have been contacted and agree to, or do not oppose, the motion, the motion is granted on an expedited basis. PGE shall file its reply to the responses of the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, NewSun Energy, LLC, Obsidian Renewables, LLC, Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, Renewable Energy Coalition, and Community Renewable Energy Association no later than January 26, 2021.
