In accordance with Chief Administrative Law Judge Moser's December 13, 2022 memorandum in the following seven proceedings: UM 2211, UM 2210, UM 2209, AR 638, AR 626, PCN 5, and LC 78, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers ("AWEC") hereby files this letter in response to STOP B2H Coalition's ("Coalition") request for intervenor funding (the "request"). As stated in the request, the Coalition seeks intervenor funding pursuant to Interim Intervenor Funding Order 22-043 under House Bill ("HB") 2475 in Docket No. UM 2211. In Order 22-043, the Commission adopted Commission Staff's recommendation to approve an agreement for interim funding for environmental justice and low-income organizations consistent with HB 2475 ("HB 2475 Grants").

It is AWEC's understanding that the Coalition's intervenor funding request seeks solely HB 2475 Grants. If this understanding is correct, AWEC takes no position on the Coalition's requests. If, however, the Coalition seeks funding from the Fourth Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement approved in Docket UM 1929, then AWEC requests that the Coalition clarify its request and that AWEC be given the opportunity to file a substantive response to this amended request.
