**Subject:** 2019 IRP Action Plan – Cholla Unit 4 Retirement Update

## **IRP Participants:**

The 2019 PacifiCorp Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) identifies specific resource actions the company will take over the next two to four years to deliver resources included in the preferred portfolio. As part of that action plan, on December 27, 2019, PacifiCorp notified Arizona Public Service (APS) that it plans to retire Cholla Unit 4 by the end of 2020. Cholla Unit 4 is a 395-megawatt coal-fired generator at the Joseph City, Arizona, Cholla Power Plant. Cholla Unit 4 is owned by PacifiCorp and operated by APS.

Both the 2017 and 2019 PacifiCorp IRPs showed continued operation of Cholla Unit 4 is no longer economic for PacifiCorp customers beyond 2020 when compared to other resource alternatives.

We are mindful that this decision impacts employees at APS, their families and communities. We will work closely with APS to help their employees and the communities remain informed about the changes ahead.
