**RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 20-04, Community Solar Program  
Interconnection and Power Purchase Schedule**

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 757.205 and 757.210 and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025 for filing proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 20-04 on February 18, 2020 with a requested effective date of March 11, 2020. The initial filing also included an application requesting a waiver of the less than 30-day notice. PGE is submitting this Supplemental Filing at the request of Staff to allow more time for review. PGE now requests an effective date of April 8, 2020.

All sheets remain as previously filed.

To satisfy the requirements of Oregon Administrative Rules 860-022-0025(2), PGE provides the following responses:

OAR 860-022-0025 requires that PGE submit a statement of the tariff schedule change, the number of Customers affected, the change in revenue, and the grounds supporting the change. The number of participants for this optional service is unknown as it is not yet available. The revenue change is therefore unknown.
